### CSR at MIDHANI

MIDHANI is committed to the well being of the society and its environs.

As a part of its social obligations and as a responsible corporate citizen Midhani has undertaken various CSR-projects in the field of Health, Education, Environment, Women Empowerment, Skill Development, for the benefit of different segments of the society especially the deprived and under privileged. "In tune with the vision of the company, Midhani through its C.S.R & Sustainability initiatives conduct business in a manner that is beneficial to both, business and society and will strive to enhance better quality of life in the community and society at large through social value creation by adoption of shared value approach to promote sustained growth." So far Midhani has taken up various projects in the above areas under CSR& Sustainability with following expenditure.

### A. Promotion of Health Care and Sanitation

In order to improve the health and hygienic conditions and infrastructure facilities of students studying in nearby Govt. Schools families (BPL) are upgraded by providing Duel desks and constructing necessary Toilets. This project not only benefited approx. 3000 students, but will also help in bringing down the girl student dropout rate at the school level.

#### 1. Promotion of sanitation at Govt. Schools:

#### A) Construction of Toilets

- B) Annual Maintenance of Toilets constructed by Midhani under swachh Bharat:

#### 2. Promotion of Health care:

Midhani has set up a Charitable Health care centre for the poor families staying in and around MIDHANI. Basic checkup and medicines are provided at free of cost to the patients. Expenditure incurred in hiring of Doctor and Medicines is Rs 3.52 lakhs.









## B. Promotion of Education

**1. Sponsored Dual Desks – 630 nos** to Government School children of Chouttuppal Mandal and Suryapet at an expenditure of Rs 21 lakhs.

 Mid-day meal to Govt. Schools : Midhani has sponsored Mid-day meal to approx. 1579 Children in 12 Government Schools of Medak Dist through M/s Akshya Patra Foundation. Expenditure in 2017-18 was Rs.15 lakhs.

## C. Skill Development:

### 1. Adoption of ITI, Alwal:

As directed by MoD, Company has adopted one Government ITI at Alwal in the State of Telangana and provided various infrastructure facilities such as compound wall, sanitation facilities, up-gradation of computer lab, renovation of welding work shop shed roof, electrical items and also arranged faculty. The total expenditure towards this initiative is around Rs 51.88 lakhs in the financial year, in addition to Rs 7 lakhs already spend in previous year.

2. Construction of Training Centre: As envisaged in CSR-policy of Midhani, efforts were made to set up skill development centre. Accordingly Construction work of Skill Development Centre cum Centre of Excellence has been taken up. Expenditure in 2017-18 is Rs.144.96 lakhs. The building construction is completed and various infrastructures are being procured to operationalize the skill development center during 2018-19.
