CSR at MIDHANI

MIDHANI Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) is viewed as a way of conducting business, which enables the creation and distribution of wealth for the betterment of its stakeholders, through the implementation and integration of ethical systems and sustainable management practices. It gives opportunity to think about and evolve relationships with stakeholders for the common good and demonstrate their commitment in this regard by adoption of appropriate business processes and strategies. MIDHANI is committed to the well being of the society and its environs.

As a part of its social obligations and as a responsible corporate citizen Midhani has undertaken various CSR-projects in the field of Health, Education, Environment, Women Empowerment, Skill Development, for the benefit of different segments of the society especially the deprived and under privileged. "In tune with the vision of the company, Midhani through its C.S.R & Sustainability initiatives conduct business in a manner that is beneficial to both, business and society and will strive to enhance better quality of life in the community and society at large through social value creation by adoption of shared value approach to promote sustained growth." So far Midhani has taken up various projects in the above areas under CSR& Sustainability with following expenditure.

I. Promotion of sanitation at Govt. Schools:

A) Construction of Toilets

- a) Location: Govt. Schools at Khammam, Dist. Telangana State & CPS Jillelguda, Telangana
- b) Total Project Expenditure: Approx. Rs. 4.68 million
- c) No of beneficiaries (Students): Boys-1000 Girls-1000

- B) Annual Maintenance of Toilets constructed by Midhani under swachh Bharat:
- a) Location: Govt. Schools, Govt. ITI- Alwal, Parigi Mandal Ranga Reddy, Bhongiri Dist.
 - b) No of Toilet units taken up for maintenance :45
 - c) Total Project Expenditure: Rs. 2.44 million
 - d) No of beneficiaries(Students): Boys-3500 Girls-3500
- C) Provided Sanitary Vending Machines & Incinerators at Government Schools and nearby schools of MIDHANI at an expenditure of Rs 0.75 million.

II. Promotion of Health care:

Midhani has set up a Charitable Health care centre for the poor families staying in and around MIDHANI. Basic checkup and medicines are provided at free of cost to the patients. Expenditure incurred in hiring of Doctor and Medicines is Rs 0.49 million.

- A) Mid-day meal to Govt. Schools : Midhani has sponsored Mid-day meal to approx. 455 students of Government Schools at Kothagudem through M/s Akshya Patra Foundation at an expenditure of Rs. 0.5 Million.
- B) Sponsored Passenger Lift to Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada for the benefit of senior faculty members, physically challenged students and most importantly the patients particularly the pregnant ladies, patients suffering from orthopedic and neurological problems having difficulty in climbing staircase. Released an amount of Rs 0.73 Million in FY 2018-19.
- C) Taken up painting & repair works at schools nearby MIDHANI at an expenditure of Rs 4.24 Millions

III. Skill Development

- A) Adoption of ITI, Alwal:

As per the scope of the MoU, Company will provide assistance for various civil works such as construction of compound wall & toilets, up-gradation of computer lab, civil renovation of hostel building, workshops, furniture for class rooms, setting up of library furniture, fans & tube lights, financial assistance for employment of teaching staff, etc. The execution is still under progress. Expenditure in 2018-19 is Rs. 3.03 Million.

- B) Construction of Center of Excellence: As envisaged in CSR-policy of Midhani, efforts were made to set up skill development centre. Accordingly construction & infrastructure works at Centre of Excellence has been taken up. Expenditure in 2018-19 is Rs. 20.82 Million.



D) Contributed Rs 1 Million to CIIE IIM Ahmedabad as advised by Joint Secretary(DIP), Ministry of Defence for promotion of Innovations for Defence Excellence (iDEX) an initiative of the Government of India launched by the Hon'ble PM.

- ❖ In compliance to the commitment given to DPE against New Development Model for the country, MIDHANI organized a camp at “Thakur Hari Prasad Institute of Research And Rehabilitation For The Mentally Handicapped (THPI)” as CSR initiative under the title “Joy of Giving” at an expenditure of Rs 0.1 Million.
