

Shri Kapil Kumar Agarwal, Deputy Manager, Finance was declared as the winner of Quiz no.1.




Dr. Jha took out the draw and announced the winner of the competition.

ADVANCEMENT OF BULLET RESISTANT PRODUCTS USING CURRENT TECHNOLOGIES

INTRODUCTION OF ARMOUR PRODUCTS AT MIDHANI:

Mishra Dhatu Nigam Limited (MIDHANI) has been manufacturing Personal protection Products (BR Jacket, BR Helmet & BR Vest), Group Protection (BR Shield, BR Morcha, BR Briefcase etc), Vehicle Armouring (Tata-407, Scorpio, Fortuner etc) & Heptr Armouring (Mi-17 Heptr) since last many years and has been supplied to many prestigious customer such as Indian Army, OFB, CAPFs, State Police etc.

WHAT IS ARMOUR:

- Role of Armour is to protect a person, structure, or device
- Achieved by absorbing the kinetic energy of the projectile
- Energy may dominantly be absorbed by plastic deformation and/or fracture processes
- Fragments as a result of the fracture process should not cause damage to what is being protected and should be arrested by another layer at the back
- Armour plate may have to fulfill two roles: a protective role and structural role
- Both roles can be fulfilled by having sufficient strength at high strain rate and appropriate thickness to provide both protection and structural requirements of the Platform (Integral Armour/Structural Armour)




Fig-1: Ballistic Firing Mechanism

In order to manufacture above products various types of raw material is being used such as Ultra High Molecular Weight Polyethylene (UHMWPE), Kevlar, Ceramic (Monolithic or tiles of SiC, B4C & Al2O3), Armour Steel, Spall Liner etc depending on the customer requirement and protection level.

ADVANCEMENT OF BULLET RESISTANT JACKET:

Bullet Resistant Jacket (BR Jacket) is a product of body armour that helps to absorb the impact and reduce or stop penetration to the torso from firearm and designed to protect the wearer's vital organs from injury caused by bullets or fragments of grenades. Multiple layers of Composite material (Ceramic+UHMWPE) are being used to manufacture Bullet Resistant Jacket as per protection level (Fig. 1) criteria defined by user.

MIDHANI has been supplying BR Jackets to customers various and continuously get feedback from customers and also the development of new technologies in the field of BR Jacket considering above it these is understood that Weight, flexibility, reliability protection level are the main important points to


be addressed for increasing the performance of the product. Accordingly, MIDHANI has already started working on research and development to address the above important points using current technological advancement in the world and subsequently has done significant work in the above-desired field. Currently, BR Jackets are being manufactured as per BIS 17051: 2018 standard and MIDHANI is also following the same standard during the manufacturing of the product.

Recently MIDHANI has developed a new MIDHANI KAVACH product (BR Jacket) using a coating of graphene nanoparticles on composite panels made of multiple layers of UHMWPE bonded with Ceramic tiles and significant improvement has been found on strength of Composite panels which is also been confirmed by ballistic testing conducted at NABL accredited lab and results were found to be satisfactory. The development reduces the weight of Bullet Resistant Jacket by 20% and significant Back Face Signature (BFS) compared to existing Jacket which is remarkably good achievement compared to existing BR Jackets as per BIS 17051: 2018 standard. IPR for this new development by MIDHANI Armouring team is already been filed and it is under evaluation process.
