Report on the Audit of the Standalone Financial Results

Opinion

- 1. We have audited the accompanying standalone financial results of Mishra Dhatu Nigam Limited (the company) for the quarter ended 31st March 2023 and for the year ended 31st March, 2023, attached herewith being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").
- 2. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these financial results:

- 3 The financial results for the year ended 31st March 2023 have been audited by the Statutory Auditors as required under Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015. An unmodified report has been issued by them thereon.
- 4 The above statement of financial results were reviewed by Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at the meeting held on 25th May 2023.
